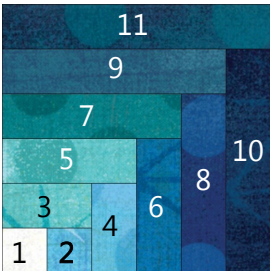
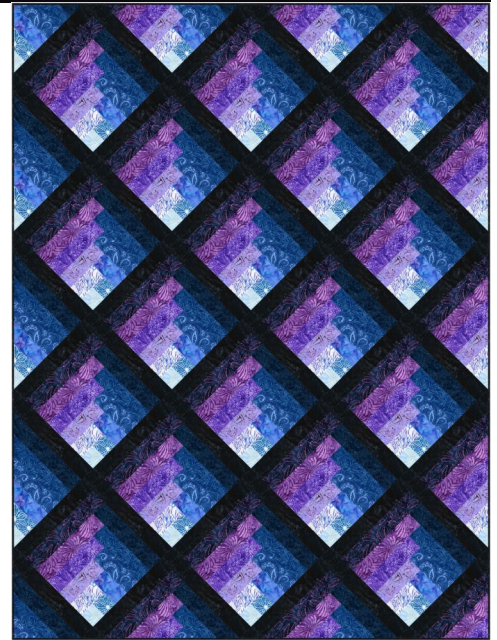


Waterfall

Waterfall is a delightful gradating ombre quilt pattern highlighting two colorways. Choose five hues from light to dark in two colorways, plus a very light fabric for the center squares and a very dark sashing color.

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BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

- All seam allowances are 1/4".
- WOF means "width of fabric", and RST means "right sides together".
- The assumed width of usable fabric is 42".
- Check <https://busyhandsquilts.com/pages/errata> for pattern corrections.
- Drawings are not to scale.
- This pattern assumes a previous knowledge of piecing, quilt top assembly, basting, quilting, and binding.
- Note that in some cases extra pieces will be cut from a strip and be unused. Totals indicate the number of pieces required.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Consider placing the pieces in small bags as you cut and label them. Group all pieces with the same letter together; all A# pieces, B# pieces, etc.

From Fabric #1, cut and label the following:

Throw	• Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (10) 2-1/2" squares from each strip; 20 total. Label 18 squares A1 and 2 squares C1. • Cut (1) 2-7/8" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 2-7/8" squares. Label 3 squares B6, 3 squares D1, 1 square F1, and 1 square G6.
Queen	• Cut (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) 2-1/2" squares from each strip; 45 total. Label 41 squares A1 and 4 squares C1. • Cut (1) 2-7/8" x WOF strip, sub-cut (10) 2-7/8" squares. Label 4 squares B6, 4 squares D1, 1 square F1, and 1 square G6.

From Fabric #2, cut and label the following:

Throw	• Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (10) 2-1/2" squares from each strip; 20 total. Label 18 squares A2 and 2 squares C2. • From remainder of strips in previous step, sub-cut (4) 5" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label 3 rectangles B5 and 1 rectangle F2.
Queen	• Cut (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) 2-1/2" squares from each strip; 45 total. Label 41 squares A2 and 4 squares C2. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (5) 5" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label 4 rectangles B5 and 1 rectangle F2.

From Fabric #3, cut and label the following:

Throw	• Cut (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (9) 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 20 total. Label 18 rectangles A3 and 2 rectangles C3. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 5" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label 3 rectangles D2 and 1 rectangle G5.
Queen	• Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (9) 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 45 total. Label 41 rectangles A3 and 4 rectangles C3. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (5) 5" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label 4 rectangles D2 and 1 rectangle G5.

From Fabric #4, cut and label the following (see next page for Queen size):

Throw	• Cut (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (9) 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 20 total. Label 18 rectangles A4 and 2 rectangles C4. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 7" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label 3 rectangles B4 and 1 rectangle F3.
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CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS (continued):

(continued) From Fabric #4, cut and label the following:

Queen	• Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (9) 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 45 total. Label 41 rectangles A4 and 4 rectangles C4. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (5) 7" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label 4 rectangles B4 and 1 rectangle F3.
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From Fabric #5, cut and label the following:

Throw	• Cut (4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (6) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 20 total. Label 18 rectangles A5 and 2 rectangles C5. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 7" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label 3 rectangles D3 and 1 rectangle G4.
Queen	• Cut (8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (6) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 45 total. Label 41 rectangles A5 and 4 rectangles C5. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (5) 7" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label 4 rectangles D3 and 1 rectangle G4.

From Fabric #6, cut and label the following:

Throw	• Cut (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (6) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 18 total. Label A6. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 9" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label B3. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label C6; then sub-cut (1) 7" x 2-1/2" rectangle, label F4. • Cut (1) 5-1/4" x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) 5-1/4" square. Cut square in half diagonally twice, creating 4 triangles. Only 1 triangle is needed. Label J3. • With the remainder of the strip from the previous step, trim strip to 2-7/8", sub-cut (2) 2-7/8" squares. Label E1.
Queen	• Cut (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (6) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 41 total. Label A6. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 9" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label B3. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label C6; then sub-cut (1) 7" x 2-1/2" rectangle, label F4. • Cut (1) 5-1/4" x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) 5-1/4" square. Cut square in half diagonally twice, creating 4 triangles. Only 1 triangle is needed. Label J3. • With the remainder of the strip from the previous step, trim strip to 2-7/8", sub-cut (4) 2-7/8" squares. Label E1.

From Fabric #7, cut and label the following (see next page for Queen size):

Throw	• Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 8-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 18 total. Label A7. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 7" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label 2 rectangles C7 and 1 rectangle G3; then sub-cut (2) 5" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label E2. • Cut (1) 5-1/4" x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) 5-1/4" square. Cut square in half diagonally twice, creating 4 triangles. Only 1 triangle is needed. Label H3. • With the remainder of the strip from the previous step, trim strip to 2-1/2", sub-cut (3) 9" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label D4.
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CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS (continued):

(continued) From Fabric #7, cut and label the following:

Queen	• Cut (11) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 8-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 41 total. Label A7. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (5) 7" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label 4 rectangles C7 and 1 rectangle G3. • Cut (1) 5-1/4 x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) 5-1/4" square. Cut square in half diagonally twice, creating 4 triangles. Only 1 triangle is needed. Label H3. • With the remainder of the strip from the previous step, trim strip to 2-1/2", sub-cut (4) 9" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label D4. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 5" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label E2.
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From Fabric #8, cut and label the following:

Throw	• Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 8-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 18 total. Label A8. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 11" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label B2. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 5" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label 2 rectangles C8 and 1 rectangle F5; then sub-cut (2) 7" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label E3; then sub-cut (1) 9-1/4" x 2-1/2" rectangle, label J2.
Queen	• Cut (11) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 8-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 41 total. Label A8. • Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 11" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 4 total. Label B2. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (5) 5" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label 4 rectangles C8 and 1 rectangle F5. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 7" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label E3; then sub-cut (1) 9-1/4" x 2-1/2" rectangle, label J2.

From Fabric #9, cut and label the following:

Throw	• Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 10-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 18 total. Label A9. • With 1 of the extra rectangles from the previous step, sub-cut (1) 9-1/4" x 2-1/2" rectangle. Label H2. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 5" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label 2 rectangles C9 and 1 rectangle G2; then sub-cut (2) 9" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label E4. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 11" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label D5.
Queen	• Cut (11) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 10-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 41 total. Label A9. • With 1 of the extra rectangles from the previous step, sub-cut (1) 9-1/4" x 2-1/2" rectangle. Label H2. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 11" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label D5. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) 11" x 2-1/2" rectangle; 4 total, add to D5 pile (4 total). Then sub-cut (4) 5" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label C9. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 9" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label E4; then sub-cut (1) 5" x 2-1/2" rectangle, label G2.



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS (continued):

From Fabric #10, cut and label the following:

Throw	• Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 10-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 18 total. Label A10. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 13" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label B1. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 11" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label E5; then sub-cut (1) 13-1/4" x 2-1/2" rectangle, label J1. • Cut (1) 2-7/8" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 2-7/8" squares, label 2 squares C10 and 1 square F6.
Queen	• Cut (11) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 10-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 41 total. Label A10. • Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut a total of (4) 13" x 2-1/2" rectangles from the strips. Label B1. • Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut a total of (4) 11" x 2-1/2" rectangles from the strips, label E5; then sub-cut (1) 13-1/4" x 2-1/2" rectangle, label J1. • Cut (1) 2-7/8" x WOF strip, sub-cut (5) 2-7/8" squares, label 4 squares C10 and 1 square F6.

From Fabric #11, cut and label the following:

Throw	• Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (3) 12-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 18 total. Label A11. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 13" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Label D6. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 13" x 2-1/2" rectangles, label E6; then sub-cut (1) 13-1/4" x 2-1/2" rectangle, label H1. • Cut (1) 2-7/8" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 2-7/8" squares. Label 2 squares C11 and 1 square G1.
Queen	• Cut (14) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (3) 12-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 41 total. Label A11. • Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (3) 13" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip. Label 4 rectangles D6 and 2 rectangles E6. • Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 13" x 2-1/2" rectangles, add to E6 rectangle pile for a total of 4 E6 rectangles; then sub-cut (1) 13-1/4" x 2-1/2" rectangle, label H1. • Cut (1) 2-7/8" x WOF strip, sub-cut (5) 2-7/8" squares. Label 4 squares C11 and 1 square G1.

From Fabric #12, cut and label the following:

Throw	• Cut (8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (3) 12-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 24 total. Label S1. • Cut (9) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Label S2.
Queen	• Cut (17) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (3) 12-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles from each strip; 50 total. Label S1. • Cut (18) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Label S2.

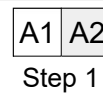
From Binding Fabric, cut the following number of 2-1/2" x WOF strips: Throw 8, Queen 11.



BLOCK A PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

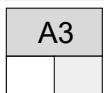
Gather all A# pieces. Press all seams open. Make Throw 18, Queen 41.

Step 1: Sew an A2 square to the right side of each A1 square.



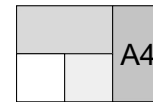

BLOCK B PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Gather all B# pieces. Align each strip at the top in all steps. Press all seams open. Make Throw 3, Queen 4.

Step 1: Sew a B2 rectangle to the right side of all B1 rectangles.

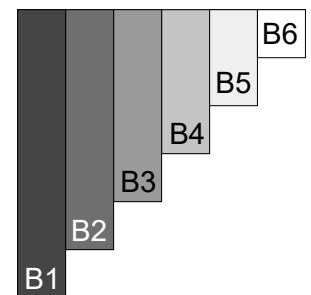
Step 2: Sew a B3 rectangle to the right side of each unit from Step 1.

Step 3: Sew a B4 rectangle to the right side of each unit from Step 2.

Step 4: Sew a B5 rectangle to the right side of each unit from Step 3.

Step 5: Sew a B6 square to the right side of each unit from Step 4.

Block B should measure 12-7/8" wide x 13" high unfinished.

BLOCK D PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Gather all D# pieces. Align each strip at the top in all steps. Press all seams open. Make Throw 3, Queen 4.

Step 1: Sew a D2 rectangle to the right side of all D1 rectangles.

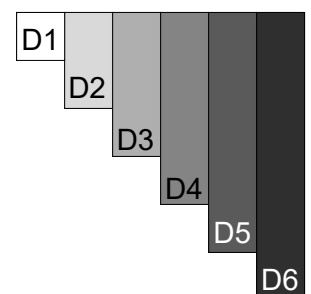
Step 2: Sew a D3 rectangle to the right side of each unit from Step 1.

Step 3: Sew a D4 rectangle to the right side of each unit from Step 2.

Step 4: Sew a D5 rectangle to the right side of each unit from Step 3.

Step 5: Sew a D6 rectangle to the right side of each unit from Step 4.

Block D should measure 12-7/8" wide x 13" high unfinished.

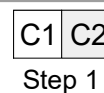

BLOCK C PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

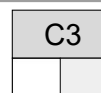
Gather all C# pieces. Press all seams open. Make Throw 2, Queen 4.

Step 1: Sew a C2 square to the right side of each C1 square.



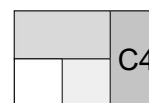

BLOCK E PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

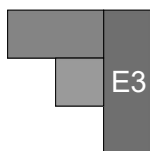
Gather all E# pieces. Press all seams open. Make Throw 2, Queen 4.

Step 1: Sew an E2 rectangle to the top of each E1 square.



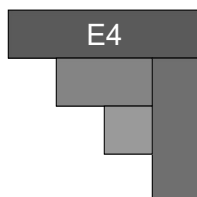

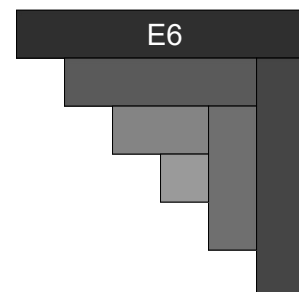

BLOCK F PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Gather all F# pieces. Align each strip at the top in all steps. Press all seams open. Make Throw 1, Queen 1.

Step 1: Sew the F5 rectangle to the right side of the F6 square.

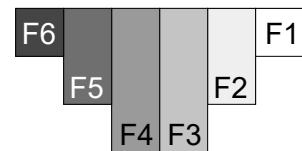
Step 2: Sew the F4 rectangle to the right side of the unit from Step 1.

Step 3: Sew the F3 rectangle to the right side of the unit from Step 2.

Step 4: Sew the F2 rectangle to the right side of the unit from Step 3.

Step 5: Sew the F1 square to the right side of the unit from Step 4.

Block F should measure 13-1/4" wide x 7" high unfinished.

BLOCK G PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Gather all G# pieces. Align each strip at the top in all steps. Press all seams open. Make Throw 1, Queen 1.

Step 1: Sew the G5 rectangle to the right side of the G6 square.

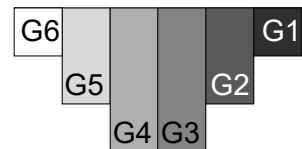
Step 2: Sew the G4 rectangle to the right side of the unit from Step 1.

Step 3: Sew the G3 rectangle to the right side of the unit from Step 2.

Step 4: Sew the G2 rectangle to the right side of the unit from Step 3.

Step 5: Sew the G1 square to the right side of the unit from Step 4.

Block G should measure 13-1/4" wide x 7" high unfinished.

BLOCK H PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

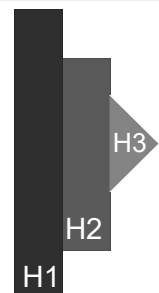
Gather all H# pieces. Press all seams open. Make Throw 1, Queen 1.

Step 1: Fold all H# pieces in half and mark the center of each piece with a crease mark.

Step 2: Sew the H2 to the right side of the H1 strip, matching crease marks.

Step 3: Sew the H3 triangle to the right side of the H2 strip, matching crease marks.

Block H should measure 6-5/8" wide x 13-1/4" high unfinished.

BLOCK J PIECING INSTRUCTIONS: (there is no Block I because the I looks like a 1).

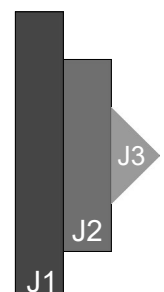
Gather all J# pieces. Press all seams open. Make Throw 1, Queen 1.

Step 1: Fold all J pieces in half and mark the center of each piece with a crease mark.

Step 2: Sew the J2 to the right side of the J1 rectangle, centering it by lining up the crease marks.

Step 3: Sew the J3 triangle to the right side of the unit from Step 3, centering it by lining up the crease marks.

Block J should measure 6-5/8" wide x 13-1/4" high unfinished.

SASHING PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sew all S2 strips together end to end with straight seams, press seams open. Label S2.

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

The Throw and Queen size layouts are shown on the following pages.

Chart Details: On each page is a chart that details which blocks are placed in each row for that quilt size. For instance, Row 1 begins with a Block B on the left, then 1 Block A, and ends with a Block C on the right; Row 2 begins with a Block B on the left, then 3 Block As, and ends with a Block C on the right.

Row Layout: Lay out the quilt top in rows, beginning with Row 1 at the upper left, placing an S1 rectangle between each block. Lay out the remaining rows in this manner. Place a Block F above Row 1, and place a Block H below the last row.

Row Assembly: Press all seams toward the sashing pieces. Sew pieces together in each row. Do not join the rows to one another just yet; sashing needs added between the rows.

Row Sashing: The S2 sashing strip is cut to length and placed between the rows of pieced blocks. Sashing strip lengths shown in the diagrams are accurate for piecing in a perfect world; your row length may vary and thus your sashing strip length may vary. The sashing strip needs to extend 1/4" beyond the first S1 rectangle and 1/4" beyond the last S1 rectangle in the row it attaches to. There is one exception to this. In the Throw size, the sashing attached to the top of Row 4 needs to extend 2" past Block D.

Measure each row length (or use the length given on the following pages) and cut a sashing strip this length. Attach the strip to the top and/or bottom of the row as shown. Repeat for all rows. Join sashed rows together, then attach Block F above Row 1 and Block H below the bottom row.

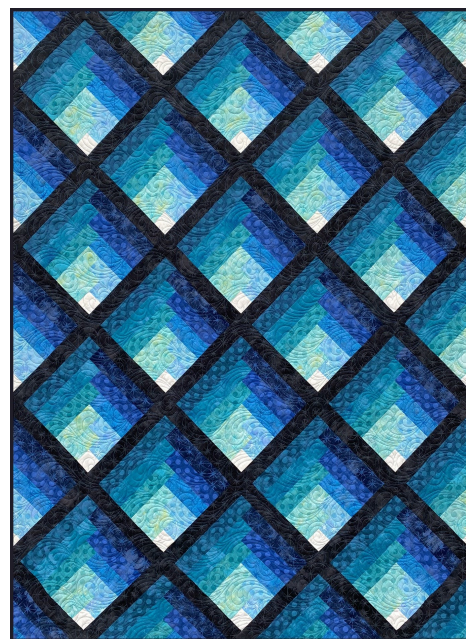
Trim the Quilt Top: Working with one edge of the quilt top at a time, lay the quilt top flat on a cutting mat and trim the quilt top 1/4" outside of the points where the S1 rectangles meet the S2 sashing strips. Repeat for remaining three sides.

FINISHING THE QUILT:

Run a line of stitching 1/8" around the edges of the quilt top to secure seams for quilting. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing; baste and quilt as desired. Sew binding strips together end to end with diagonal seams; press in half lengthwise. Add a label. Bind quilt. You're done!

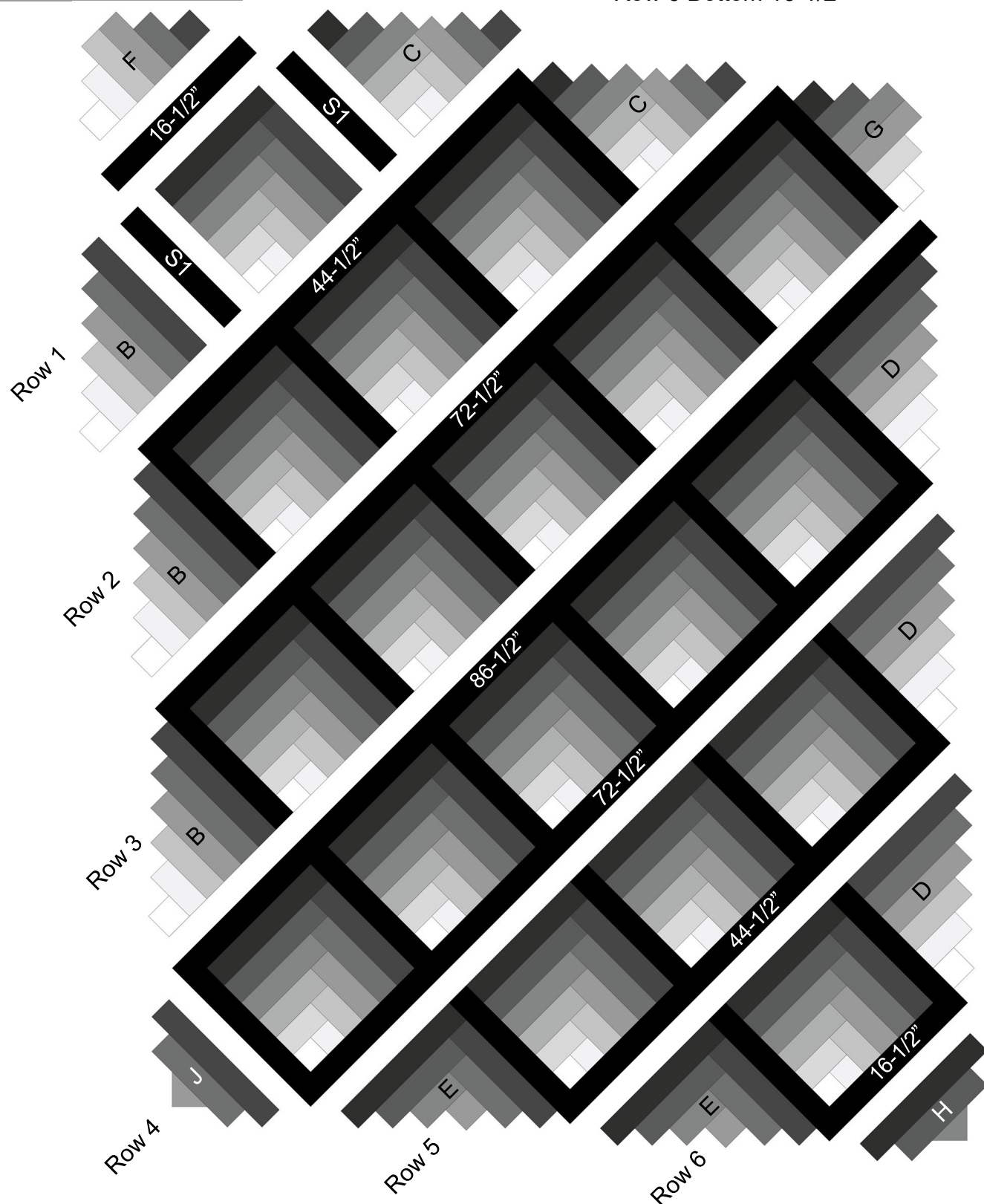
