Crochet pattern - Lovely Bib

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IMPORTANT INFORMATION

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DESIGNERS NOTE

In the first part of the pattern, you will find a description of the materials you need. After that, there will be a detailed description of some special stitches used in the pattern following by some "good to know before you start" information and measurements of a finished item in the different sizes.

A written description will be found in the beginning of each step. If you get stuck, feel free to read that description but use the same amount of stitches in the size you are making. A short printable description can be found in the end followed by a project planner.

When I write my patterns, I do it in a way that everyone can understand regardless of your crocheting skills. I want you to succeed with a perfect result!

I wish you all the best of luck with your project. And I'm always glad to help if you have any further questions.



MATERIALS

- Yarn, super fine/fingering – For this pattern I have used Rainbow Cotton 8/4 from Hobbii. 50g=170m approx. (186 yds)
- Weight: 18 gr for the small size, 20 gr for the Large size,
- Hook: EU: 2,5-3,5mm / US C-E/2-4 or whichever one you find suitable for your preferred yarn.
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

Techniques in the pattern — special stitches

Front post single crochet (FPsc)

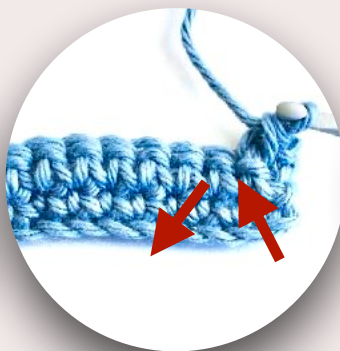
The front post single crochet is a post stitch. This means that the stitch is worked into the round below and around the post of the lower stitch. Insert your hook from front to back to front. Yarn over and make a single crochet. Continue to work around the next post.



Insert your hook in the first stitch.



Go around the post and out to the front again. Make a SC.



Work next FPsc around the next post.



When done, it should look like this.

Front post half double crochet (FPhdc)

FPhdc stitches have the same effect as the front post single crochet. When crocheting the FPhdc you work your yarn around the posts of previous round just as with the FPsc stitch. Yarn over, insert your hook from front to back to front, around the post, yarn over and make a half double crochet. Continue to work around the next post.



Yarn over and insert your hook in the first stitch.



Go around the post and out to the front again. Yarn over and pull up a loop, make a HDC.



Work next FPhdc around the next post.



When done, it should look like this.

Crossed double crochet (CDC)

To work a crossed double crochet, you will be working two double crochets close to how you normally would, but you will be placing them in different stitches. Make 1 double crochet, skip 1 stitch. Yarn over and make a double crochet. Now cross the DC you just made and make a new by skipping the stitch you already skipped and simply make a double crochet in the same stitch as your first double crochet.



Skip 1 st and make 1 DC.



Cross the DC and make one more DC.



Skip 1 st and make 1 DC.



Cross the DC and make one more DC.



When done, it should look like this.

V-Stitch (Vs)

The V-stitch gives you a row of beautiful looking V's. Make 1 double crochet in the bottom of CH 3. Skip 2 stitches and make 1 double crochet, chain 2 and make 1 more double crochet in the same stitch as your previous one. To complete each V-stitch, work 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC in the same stitch and repeat as many times as instructed.



Skip 2 st and make 1 DC



Chain 2 and make 1 DC in the same st



Skip 2 and continue making V-st



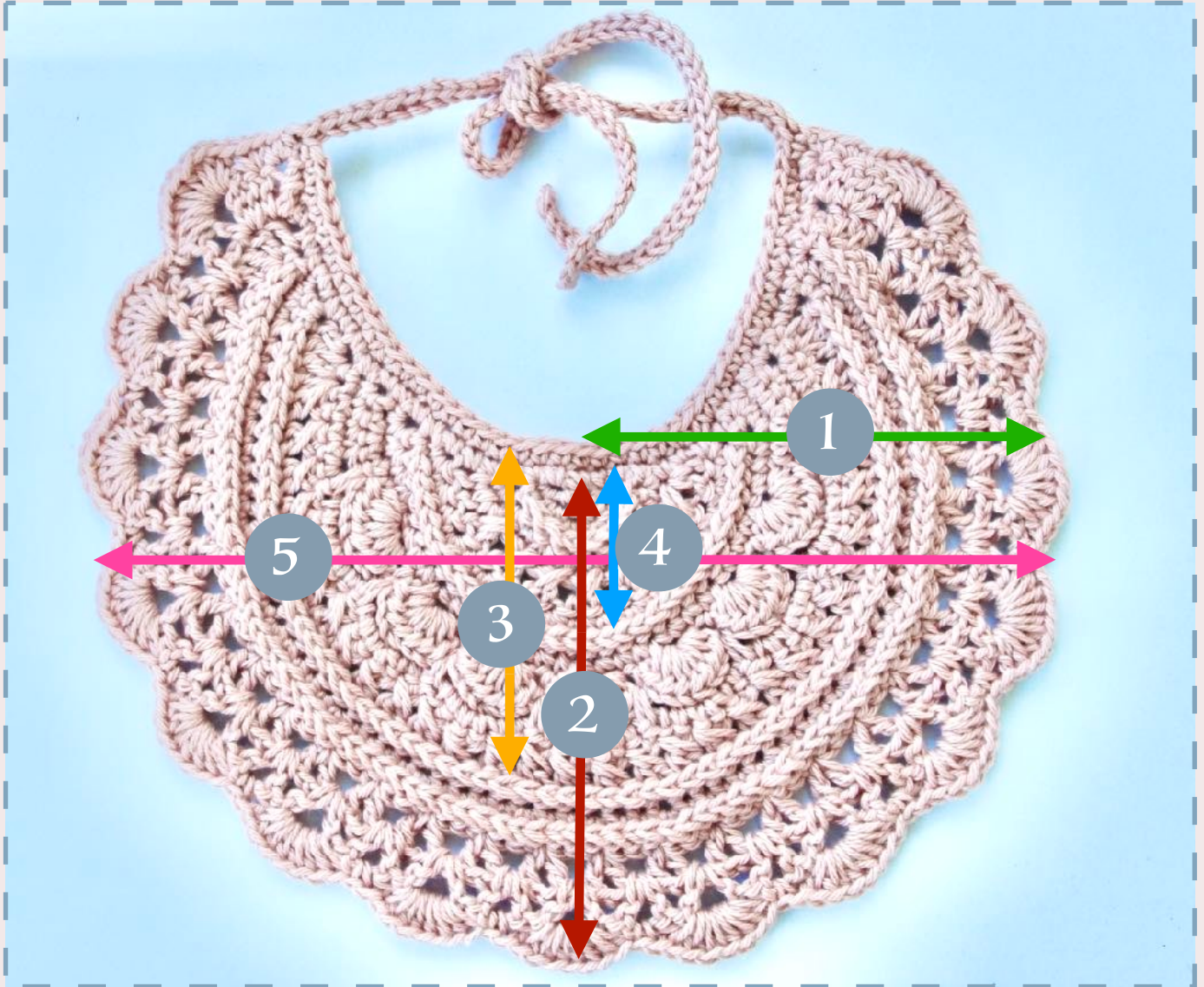
Should look like this

Good to know before you start

- Each "turn CH 1" is not counted in the pattern.
- No stitches are made in the first CH (turning chain) of each round.
- Make sure you have the correct number of stitches once you finish every round.
- The number within () after every round shows how many stitches each round is supposed to have excluded the CH 1.

- Below, you can see the approximate measurements for your finished bib depending on which size you make.

Detailed description round 1-4

All Sizes

1. Start with a magic ring (leave a tail of 10 cm). Make 6 single crochets + 1 turning chain. You now have a tail of yarn, pull it to tighten the magic ring. To make sure the hole stays tight, put the hook through the MR and pull the tail through a little bit and then pull the yarn through the loop you just made (a SLst), pull to tighten. - Turn
2. 1 single crochet, increase by making 2 single crochets (4 SCinc) in each of the 4 coming stitches. Finish with 1 single crochet, chain 1 - Turn
3. Make 9 front post single crochets as instructed on page 3 in this pattern. The last stitch will be a regular single crochet, make it in the same stitch as your last FPsc, chain 1 - Turn
4. 1 single crochet increase, 2 single crochet, increase by making 2 single crochets (4SCinc) in each of the 4 coming stitches. 2 single crochet, 1 single crochet increase, chain 3 - Turn

Make a magic ring, 6 SC, 1 CH - Turn (6)

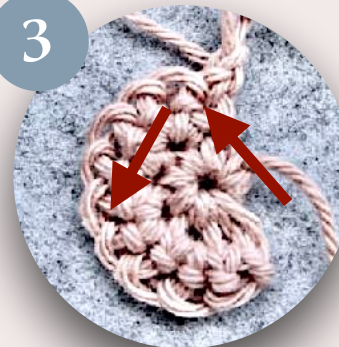

All Sizes

5. Increase with 2 double crochet in first stitch. Make 7 crossed double crochet as instructed on page 4. Continue with 1 double crochet in the same stitch as your last crossed double crochet and increase with 2 double crochets in the last stitch, chain 1. - Turn

RND 5:

1 DCinc, 7 CDC, 1 DC, 1 DCinc, CH 1 - Turn. (19)



Detailed description round 6

2 Sizes

S & L:

6. In this round you will make only single crochet for the small size and half double crochet for the large size. Follow the instructions as directed for the size you are making.

Start as directed, The instruction within the () will be repeated 3 times, work the increase stitches and repeat the instruction within the second (), finish by increasing, chaining and turning.

RND 6:

1 SCinc, (1 SCinc, 1 SC) x 3, 1 SCinc x5, (1SC, 1 SCinc) x3, 1 SCinc, CH 1 - Turn. (32)



Large

RND 6:

CH 1, 1 HDCinc, (1 HDCinc, 1 HDC) x3, 1 HDCinc x5, (1HDC, 1 HDCinc) x3, 1 HDCinc, CH 2- Turn. (32)

Detailed description round 7

2 Sizes

S & L:

7. In this round you will make front post stitches. Start the round by increasing as directed and start your first post stitch in the same stitch as your increase. Continue and make 30 post stitches as directed and finish this round by increasing, chaining 1 and turning.

1 SCinc, 30 FPsc, 1 SCinc, 1 CH - Turn

Detailed description round 8

All Sizes

8. 2 single crochet increase, 3 single crochet. Chain 2, 4 single crochet, repeat 6 times.

(2 CH, 4 SC) x6. Chain 2, 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet increase and finish the round by chaining 1 (You should now have seven small holes on your bib). - Turn

RND 8:

1 SCinc x 2, 3 SC (CH 2, 4 SC) x 6, CH 2, 3 SC, 1 SCinc x 2, CH 1 - Turn

All Sizes

9. Start by making 2 single crochet, 1 single crochet increase and 2 single crochet. Skip 2 stitches, Make 1 cluster with 8 half double crochet in the small space from the previous round. Skip 1 stitch (it is a little bit hidden under the cluster, see picture) and make 1 single crochet in the second stitch. Start with the next cluster directly in the next small space (you will skip 2 stitches from the previous round). Continue and make a total of 7 clusters. Finish this round with 2 single crochet, 1 single crochet increase, 2 single crochet, chain 1. - Turn

RND 9:

(18 sc, 7 CL)

2 SC, 1 SCinc, 2 SC, SK 2, (1 CL (8hdc) SK 1, 1 SC) x6, SK 2, 1 CL (8hdc), SK 2, 2 SC, 1 SCinc, 2 SC, CH 1 - Turn.



Detailed description round 10

All Sizes

10. Start with 4 single crochet, chain 5 and attach the chain with 1 single crochet in the middle of the next cluster. Make 6 more chains which you attach in the same way. When you have done the 8th and last chain, skip 6 stitches and continue in the 7th stitch (4th stitch counted from the end). Finish with 4 single crochet in the last 4 stitches, chain 1. - Turn

RND 10:

4 SC, (CH 5, 1 SC in the middle of next CL) x7, CH 5, SK 6, 4 SC, CH 1- Turn (15)



Detailed description round II

11. In this round you will crochet around the chains from the previous round. Start with 1 single crochet increase and 3 single crochet in the first 4 stitches. Continue and make 2 single crochet around the chain, 1 half double crochet in the first stitch before the cluster in the round below (see picture). Continue with 2 more single crochet around the chain. Increase with 2 single crochet in the stitch on the top of the cluster. Repeat 6 more times, you will have a total of 7 increases on top of the clusters from round 9.

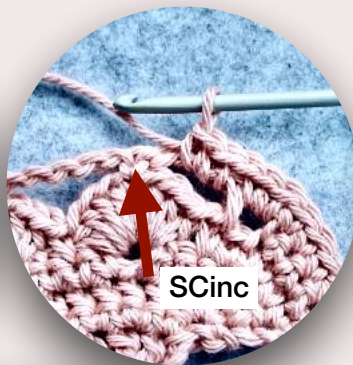
When crocheting half double crochets you will make them in the only single crochet between the clusters, see picture below. Once you have completed your 7th single crochet increase on the top of the last cluster, continue around the last chain with 2 single crochet and 1 half double crochet, which you attach in the first single crochet after the last cluster. Make 2 more single crochet around the chain. Finish the round with 3 single crochet and 1 single crochet increase.

1 SCinc, 3 SC, (2 SC around chain, 1 HDC between CL, 2 SC around the chain, 1 SCinc) x7, 2 SC around the chain, 1 HDC in the end of last CL, 2 SC around the chain, 3 SC, 1 SCinc, CH 3 - Turn

12. Now it is time for Crossed double crochet again. Start by making 2 double crochet increases in the 2 first stitches. Continue with the crossed double crochet stitch, see explanation on page 4. When you have completed this round, you will have 30 crossed double crochet stitches and a total of 68 stitches. Finish this round by making 2 double crochet increases in the 2 last stitches. Chain 1. - Turn

1 DCinc x2, 30 CDC, 1 DCinc x2, CH 1 - Turn

(68)



Detailed description round 13

2 Sizes

S & L

13. Start by increasing in the first stitch. Now start making front post stitches. Start in the same stitch as the increase. Make a total of 67 post stitches. Finish the round with 1 increase stitch in the same stitch as the last post stitch, chain as instructed and turn.

1 SCinc, 67 FPsc, 1 SCinc, CH 1 - Turn

CH 1, 1 HDCinc in the first stitch, 67 FPhdc, 1 HDCinc in the last stitch, CH 2 - Turn

Detailed description round 14

2 Sizes

S & L

14. In this round you will be working single crochets for the small size and half double crochets for the large size. Just make them as instructed below. You will start by making 1 stitch and increasing twice. Repeat the instruction within the parenthesis 6 times (4 stitches, 1 increase stitch) The middle part will be worked with 2 stitches, 1 increase stitch and 2 more stitches. Repeat the next instruction 6 times and finish by increasing twice, 1 stitch, chain and turn.

1 SC, 1 SCinc x 2, (4 SC, 1 SCinc) x6, 2 SC, 1 SCinc, 2 SC,
(1 SCinc, 4 SC) x 6, 1 SCinc x 2, 1 SC, CH 1 – Turn

1 HDC, 1 HDCinc x 2, (4 HDC, 1 HDCinc) x 6, 2 HDC, 1 HDCinc, 2 HDC,
(1 HDCinc, 4 HDC) x6, 1 HDCinc x 2, 1 HDC, CH 2 - Turn

2 Sizes

S & L

15. Start with one SC or HDC. Now start making front post stitches. Start in the same stitch and make a total of 89 post stitches. Finish the round with 1 SC or HDC in the same stitch as the last post stitch. Chain 3 and - Turn.

1 SC, 87 FPsc, 1 SC, CH 3 — Turn (89)

Large

RND 15:

1 HDC, 87 FPhdc, 1 HDC, CH 3 — Turn (89)

Detailed description round 16

All Sizes

16. It's time for V-stitches. Start with 1 double crochet, increase once and make 1 more double crochet. Skip 2 stitches and make 1 double crochet in the third stitch. Chain 2 and make the next double crochet in the same stitch as your previous double crochet. Repeat 27 times so you get 27 V-stitches. Continue the round by skipping 2 stitches, make 1 double crochet in the third stitch, increase in the next stitch and make 1 double crochet in the last stitch. Chain 3. - Turn

RND 16:

1 DC, 1 DCinc, 1 DC, (1 V-st) x 27, SK 2, 1 DC, 1 DCinc, 1 DC, CH 3 - Turn

(62, 27 V-st + 8 dc)



Detailed description round 17

All Sizes

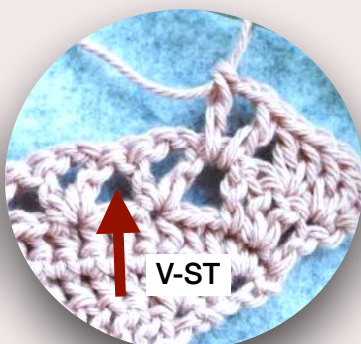
17. Start by making 1 double crochet increase twice. Continue with your next double crochet in the space between your V-stitches from the previous round, see picture below. Chain 2 and make 1 double crochet in the same space as the last double crochet. Repeat throughout the round. The last V-st is not worked in an upside down V. When making the last V-st you will need to skip 2 stitches as the picture shows below. Make 1 double crochet in the same stitch as your last V-st and finish the round with 1 double crochet increase. Chain 1 and -Turn.

RND 17:

1 DCinc x 2, (1 V-st) x 28 (Crochet these in your upside-down Vs from the previous round.) Sk2, 1 V-st, 1 DC in the same stitch as your last V-st, 1 DCinc, CH 1- Turn

(65, 29 Vs+8DC)



Detailed description round 18

All Sizes

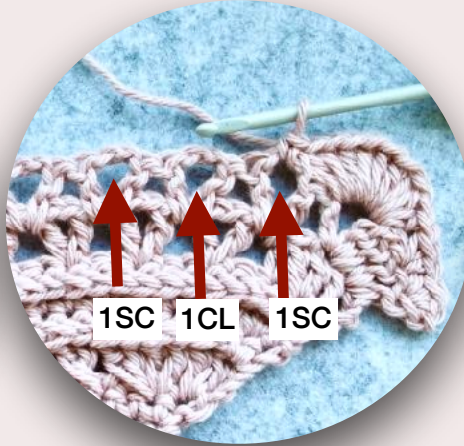
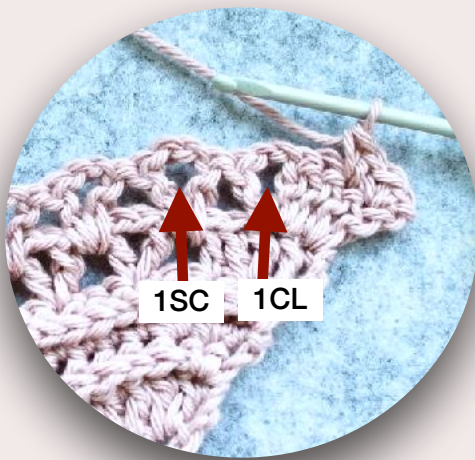
18. Start by making 2 single crochet increase. Make 1 cluster with 9 half double crochet in the V-stitch space from the previous round. Make 1 single crochet in the next V-stitch space. Repeat until you have a total of 15 clusters. Skip 3 stitches and make 2 single crochet increase in your last 2 stitches (see picture below) chain 1. Do not turn, do not cut yarn

RND 18:

(15 CL + 22 SC)

1 SCinc x2, (1 CL with 9 HDC in Vs, 1 SC in next Vs) x 14, 1 CL with 9 HDC in Vs, SK 3, 1 SCinc x2, CH 1. - Turn

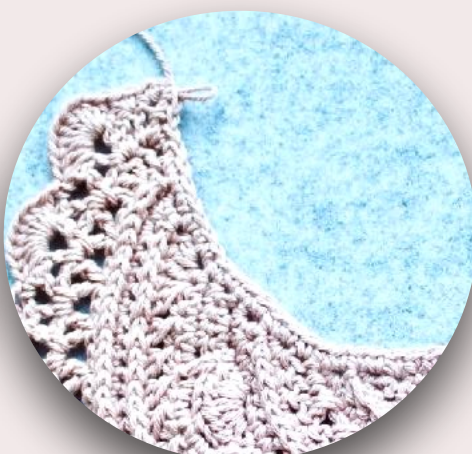
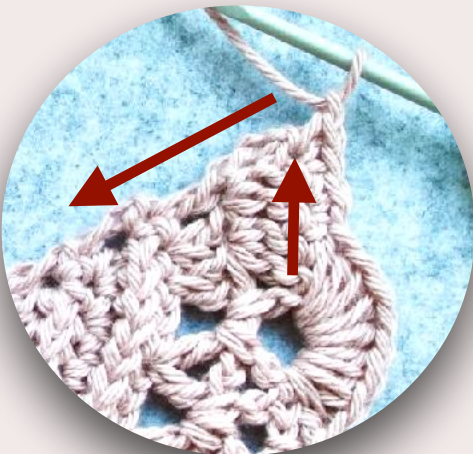


Detailed description round 19

All Sizes

19. 42 SC along the top of the bib (neck).

Crochet along the top of the bib. Make 1 single crochet in every round. Start in the same stitch as the last single crochet from row 18. Crochet 21 single crochet, as you reach the middle of your bib and the yarn tail from your magic ring, continue making 21 more single crochet while weaving in your yarn tail. Once you reach the end you will continue with the straps. Do not cut the yarn.



Notes

Straps

Information: Chain 55 to start with your first strap, turn and work 54 SC or SLst along the chain. When you have made your last stitch make 1 SLst in the next st on the side of the bib, cut the yarn after step 1, do not continue to work along the neck opening. You need to work twice around the opening to get it nice and even. If you don't cut the yarn and continue back to the other side, you will get the wrong side of the single crochets showing so it is worth the extra work to get the right side up and get it nice and even. Continue and work as instructed in step 2 and 3.

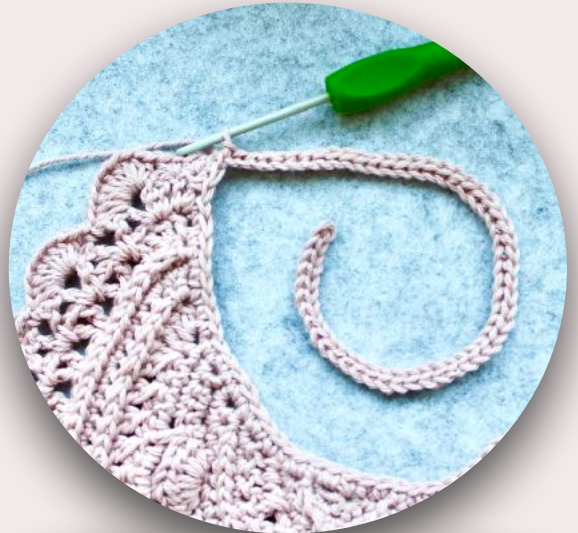
CH 55, turn, 54 SC or SLst along the chain, 1 SLst in the next stitch, CH 1 – Cut yarn (leave a 10 cm tail) pull to tighten.

Other side: Attach yarn and CH 55, turn, 54 SC or SLst along the chain. When reaching the end of chain (the top of the bib) continue with 42 single crochets along the neck opening until you reach the other side. Finish your round with 1 slip stitch and chain 1. Cut yarn (leave a 10 cm tail) pull to Tighten.

To fasten off your yarn tails, weave them in until they meet in the middle, see picture. Make a knot and weave in the loose ends in the back of the bib.

CH 55, turn, 54 SC or SLst along the chain, 1 SLst in the next stitch, CH 1 – Cut yarn (leave a 10 cm tail) pull to tighten.

To fasten off your yarn tails, weave them in until they meet in the middle, see picture on page 15. Make a knot and weave in the loose ends.

2

Attach yarn and crochet a chain of 55 stitches, turn. Start in the 2nd chain from hook make 54 single crochet along the chain. When reaching the end of the chain, (the top of the bib) continue with 42 single crochets along the neck opening until you reach the other side. Finish your round with 1 slip stitch and chain 1. Cut the yarn (leave a 10 cm tail) pull to Tighten.
