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👑 Amigurumi Our Lady of Fatima – Free Crochet Pattern

Create this exquisite representation of **Our Lady of Fatima** complete with golden crown, embroidered robe, praying hands, rosary, and Immaculate [Heart](#). A stunning devotional piece or heartfelt gift for sacraments, feasts, or home altars.

🌟 Skill Level

Advanced – Includes complex assembly, embroidery, shaping, and layered components.

Finished Size

Approx. 9–10 in (23–25 cm) tall using DK-weight yarn and a 2.5–3 mm hook.

Materials

- **Yarn (DK weight):**
 - Skin tone (peach or beige)
 - Brown (hair)
 - White (robe, veil)
 - Red (heart, crown cushion)
 - Green ([leaves](#))
 - Gold or mustard (embroidery, crown, rosary, robe trim)
 - Pink (cheeks)
 - Black (optional: eyes or embroidery details)
 - Crochet hook: 2.5–3 mm
 - Fiberfill stuffing
 - Tapestry needle
 - Stitch marker
 - Sewing pins (for positioning parts)
 - Thin wire or metallic thread (optional for crown structure)
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Abbreviations (US Terms)

MR – Magic Ring

sc – Single Crochet

inc – Increase

dec – Decrease

ch – Chain

sl st – Slip Stitch

FO – Fasten Off

Head (Skin tone)

1. MR, 6 sc
2. inc ×6 (12)
3. (1 sc, inc) ×6 (18)
4. (2 sc, inc) ×6 (24)

5. (3 sc, inc) ×6 (30)
6–12. sc around (30)
6. (3 sc, dec) ×6 (24)
7. (2 sc, dec) ×6 (18)
8. (1 sc, dec) ×6 (12)
Stuff firmly
9. dec ×6 (6), FO and close

Eyes: embroider closed eyes with black thread (between rounds 7–9)

Cheeks: stitch with soft pink or blush yarn



Hair Cap (Brown)

1. MR, 6 sc
 2. inc ×6 (12)
 3. (1 sc, inc) ×6 (18)
 4. (2 sc, inc) ×6 (24)
 5. (3 sc, inc) ×6 (30)
6–10. sc around (30)
 6. Create soft center part by working 7 sl st, sc 16, 7 sl st
FO and sew to top and sides of head
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Arms & Praying Hands (Make 2 – Skin tone → White)

1. MR, 5 sc
2–4. sc around (5)
Switch to white
5–9. sc around (5)
Do not stuff. Flatten and sew both hands together in praying position.
Attach to front of body before robe.
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Body (White)

1. MR, 6 sc
2. inc ×6 (12)
3. (1 sc, inc) ×6 (18)
4. (2 sc, inc) ×6 (24)
5. (3 sc, inc) ×6 (30)

6. (4 sc, inc) ×6 (36)
7–28. sc around (36)
Add slight flare with scallop edge if desired:
(1 sc, skip 1 st, 5 dc in next, skip 1, sl st) × repeat
FO and stuff
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Immaculate Heart

Heart (Red)

1. MR, 6 sc
2. inc ×6 (12)
3. (1 sc, inc) ×6 (18)
4. sc around
Split top into two bumps:
 - Work 9 sc, turn, sc 2 rows, dec → FO
 - Attach yarn to next unworked st, repeat bumpSew to chest

Leaves (Green – make 2)

Ch 5, sc 1, hdc 1, dc 1, sl st
Sew to sides of heart

Veil / Mantle

1. Ch 40–45 (adjust width)
2. sc across
Repeat until approx. 6–7 in long
Optional shaping: Decrease 1 st at each end every 2 rows for tapered tip
FO, sew to back of head and shoulders

Trim (Gold)

Surface crochet or backstitch around veil edges

Embroidery (Gold)

Use chain stitch or lazy [daisy](#) stitch for large [flowers](#)
Stitch mirrored patterns along veil edges, symmetrical front and back

Rosary

Chain:

Ch 25–30 using gold yarn

Cross:

Ch 6, sl st back for vertical

Ch 3, sl st for horizontal, stitch across 3rd ch of vertical

Attach to end of chain

Sew around joined hands and chest



Crown (Red & Gold)

Red Cushion Dome

1. MR, 6 sc
 2. inc ×6 (12)
 3. (1 sc, inc) ×6 (18)
 4. (2 sc, inc) ×6 (24)
 - 5–6. sc around (24)
- FO and lightly stuff

Golden Crown Base

1. MR, 6 sc
 2. inc ×6 (12)
 3. (1 sc, inc) ×6 (18)
 4. sc around (18)
 5. BLO sc around (18)
 - 6–8. sc around (18)
- FO. Attach to red cushion dome

Crown Arches

Option A – Yarn Only (small sizes):

- Make 6 arches: ch 15–20, sl st ends to opposite sides of crown base
- Pin each chain to form an arch and sew to top center
- Stiffen with fabric stiffener, diluted glue, or spray starch

Option B – Wire-Reinforced (recommended):

- Crochet around thin wire: ch 20, sc over wire
- Bend into arch and sew securely to both base and top

Cross (Gold)

1. Ch 6, sl st back (vertical)
2. At 3rd ch: ch 3, sl st (horizontal)
3. Optional: ch 3, picot at top
Attach where all arches meet

Crown Shaping Summary

Element	Method	Notes
Cushion Dome	Red half-sphere	Stuffed lightly
Base Ring	Gold ring	Slightly tall to cradle dome
Arches	Chains or wire	6 symmetrical, stiffened
Cross	Chained cross	Mounted at top center

Assembly

- Sew head to body
 - Position and attach arms in praying position
 - Stitch veil along top and back of head
 - Embroider veil and trim with gold
 - Attach Immaculate Heart and sew rosary over hands
 - Place and secure crown last
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Optional Enhancements

- Use metallic thread for embroidery
 - Add small LED halo or base lights
 - Use felt backing for veil flowers for added dimension
